## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for large capacity
- ammunition magazine permit and for large capacity ammunition
- 4 magazines prohibition; authorizing the Attorney General to
- issue permits; and imposing penalties.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 9 Statutes is amended by adding sections to read:
- 10 § 6121.1. Large capacity ammunition magazine permit.
- 11 Upon showing good cause, the Attorney General may issue a
- 12 permit for the sale, offering or exposing for sale, use,
- 13 purchase, possession or control of a large capacity ammunition
- 14 magazine to a person seeking to qualify for an exception to the
- 15 prohibition under section 6121.2 (related to large capacity
- 16 <u>ammunition magazines prohibition</u>).
- 17 § 6121.2. Large capacity ammunition magazines prohibition.
- 18 (a) Offense defined. -- Except as set forth in subsection (b),
- 19 a person commits an offense if the person does the following:
