6	Section 1. Section 2962(c) of Title 34 of the Pennsylvania							
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended and the section is amended by

11	(c) Unlawful actsIt is unlawful for any person [to]:							
12	(1) [Import] <u>To import</u> into this Commonwealth, possess,							
13	buy, sell, locate or find for a fee, barter, donate, give							
14	away or otherwise dispose of more than one bird or one animal							
15	classified as exotic wildlife in any calendar year without							
16	first securing a permit issued under this section.							
17	(2) [Release] <u>To release</u> exotic wildlife into the wild.							
18	(3) [Fail] <u>To fail</u> to exercise due care in safeguarding							

1	the public from attack by exotic wildlife.						
2	(4) [Recklessly] <u>To recklessly</u> engage in conduct which						
3	places or may place another person in danger of attack by						
4	exotic wildlife.						
5	(5) Who owns, operates or manages a facility that						
6	harbors exotic wildlife, to permit the taking of live exotic						
7	wildlife by any person who pays a fee, if the taking is by						
8	any of the following means:						
9	(i) The shooting or spearing of exotic wildlife that						
10	is tied or hobbled.						
11	(ii) The shooting or spearing of exotic wildlife						
12	that is staked or attached to any object.						
13	(iii) The shooting or spearing of exotic wildlife						
14	that is confined in a box, pen, cage or similar container						
15	or in a fenced or other area from which there is no means						
16	for the wildlife to escape.						
17	(iv) The deliberate release of exotic wildlife that						
18	is confined in a box, pen, cage or similar container or						
19	in a fenced or other area from which there is no means						
20	for the wildlife to escape in the presence of any person						
21	who is, or will be, shooting or spearing the wildlife.

23	(f) DefinitionsAs used in this section, the following						
24	words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this						
25	subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:						
26	"Fee." Includes, but is not limited to, the payment of any						
27	compensation or remuneration for room, board, meals, lodging or						
28	any other goods or services on the property where the exotic						
29	wildlife is located.
