## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous
- articles, further providing for locking device for firearms.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 6142(a) and (f) of Title 18 of the
- 7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
- 8 § 6142. Locking device for firearms.
- 9 (a) Offense defined. -- It shall be unlawful for any licensee
- 10 to sell, deliver or transfer any firearm as defined in section
- 11 6102 (relating to definitions), other than an antique firearm as
- 12 defined in section 6118 (relating to antique firearms), to any
- 13 other person, other than another licensee, unless the transferee
- 14 is provided with or purchases a locking device for that firearm
- 15 or [the design of the firearm incorporates a locking device] a\_
- 16 secure, lockable storage container for that firearm.

- 18 (f) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following

- 1 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 2 subsection:
- 3 "Licensee." Any licensed manufacturer, importer or dealer of
- 4 firearms.
- 5 "Locking device." [Either of the following:
- 6 (1) a]  $\underline{A}$  device that, when installed on a firearm, is
- 7 designed to prevent the firearm from being operated without
- 8 first deactivating the device.[; or
- 9 (2) a device that is incorporated into the design of a
- 10 firearm and that is designed to prevent the operation of the
- firearm by anyone not having access to the device.]
- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
