7	Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
9	§ 6108.1. Carrying firearms while under the influence of
10	alcohol.
11	(a) Offense definedIt shall be unlawful for a person who
12	holds a license to carry a firearm on or about his person to
13	carry a firearm after imbibing a sufficient amount of alcohol
14	such that the alcohol concentration in the person's blood or
15	breath is at least 0.08%.
16	(b) Grading
17	(1) A person who violates subsection (a) commits a
18	summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to

- 1 pay a fine of \$100. A first offense may also result in the
- 2 <u>suspension of the license for a period not to exceed three</u>
- 3 <u>years.</u>
- 4 (2) A second or subsequent offense under subsection (a)
- 5 constitutes a misdemeanor of the third degree and shall be
- 6 <u>punishable by a fine of \$500. A second or subsequent offense</u>
- 7 <u>shall also result in the suspension of the license for a</u>
- 8 period of at least three years or in the permanent revocation
- 9 of the license.
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
