2	(1) The population shall not include persons who are
3	incarcerated in Federal, State or private correctional
4	facilities and were not residents of this Commonwealth before
5	their incarceration.
6	(2) The population shall include persons who are
7	incarcerated in Federal, State or private correctional
8	facilities and were residents of this Commonwealth before their
9	incarceration. The persons specified under this paragraph shall
10	be considered residents of the congressional district or State
11	legislative district according to their last known address.
12	Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
