## AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous 2 articles, providing for the offense of carrying firearms 3 while under the influence of alcohol. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: § 6108.1. Carrying firearms while under the influence of 10 alcohol. 11 (a) Offense defined. -- It shall be unlawful for a person who 12 holds a license issued under this chapter to carry a firearm on 13 or about the person to carry a firearm after imbibing a sufficient amount of alcohol such that the alcohol concentration 14 15 in the person's blood or breath is at least 0.08%. 16 (b) Grading.--(1) A person who violates subsection (a) commits a 17 summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to 18

- 1 pay a fine of \$100. A first offense may also result in the
- 2 <u>suspension of the license issued under this chapter for a</u>
- 3 period not to exceed three years.
- 4 (2) A second or subsequent offense under subsection (a)
- 5 <u>constitutes a misdemeanor of the third degree and shall be</u>
- 6 punishable by a fine of \$500. A second or subsequent offense
- 7 <u>shall also result in the suspension of the license issued</u>
- 8 <u>under this chapter for a period of at least three years or in</u>
- 9 <u>the permanent revocation of the license.</u>
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
