AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous 2 articles, further providing for the offense of sale or 3 transfer of firearms. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 6111(g)(5) and (6) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read: 8 § 6111. Sale or transfer of firearms. * * * 10 11 (q) Penalties. --12 13 Notwithstanding section 306 (relating to liability for conduct of another; complicity) or any other statute to 14 15 the contrary, any person, licensed importer, licensed dealer 16 or licensed manufacturer who knowingly and intentionally sells, delivers or transfers a firearm in violation of this 17 18 chapter [who has reason to believe that the firearm is

- intended to be used in the commission of a crime or attempt
 to commit a crime shall be criminally liable for such crime
 or attempted crime] shall be criminally liable for any crime
 or attempted crime in which the firearm is used.
 - (6) Notwithstanding any act or statute to the contrary, any person, licensed importer, licensed manufacturer or licensed dealer who knowingly and intentionally sells or delivers a firearm in violation of this chapter [who has reason to believe that the firearm is intended to be used in the commission of a crime or attempt to commit a crime] shall be liable in the amount of the civil judgment for injuries suffered by any person [so injured by such crime or attempted crime] who is injured during any crime or attempted crime in which the firearm is used.
