A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 2 3	Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, further providing for exemptions and special provisions.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby resolves as follows:
6	Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
7	Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
8	That section 2(c) of Article VIII be amended to read:
9	§ 2. Exemptions and special provisions.

11	(c) [Citizens and residents of this Commonwealth, who served
12	in any war or armed conflict in which the United States was
13	engaged and were honorably discharged or released under
14	honorable circumstances from active service, shall be exempt
15	from the payment of all real property taxes upon the residence
16	occupied by the said citizens and residents of this Commonwealth

imposed by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or any of its 1 2 political subdivisions if, as a result of military service, they 3 are blind, paraplegic or double or quadruple amputees or have a service-connected disability declared by the United States 4 Veterans Administration or its successor to be a total or 100% 5 6 permanent disability, and if the State Veterans' Commission 7 determines that such persons are in need of the tax exemptions 8 granted herein. This exemption shall be extended to the 9 unmarried surviving spouse upon the death of an eligible veteran 10 provided that the State Veterans' Commission determines that such person is in need of the exemption.] A veteran of the 11 <---United States Armed Forces, including a reserve component of the 12 13 United States Armed Forces, who has been rated by the United State Department of Veterans Affairs or its successor as 100% 14 15 permanent and totally disabled or compensated at the 100% 16 disability rate through a Federal program that provides 17 compensation to veterans who are unable to work due to a 18 service connected disability shall be exempt from payment of 19 real property taxes. A political subdivision may, by ordinance 20 or resolution, exempt a veteran with a disability rated or compensated at any level below 100% from payment of any portion-21 of real property taxes. This subsection shall apply to the 22 23 unmarried surviving spouse upon the death of an eligible 24 veteran, as well as the unmarried surviving spouses of service 25 members who died in the line of duty, are taken as prisoners of 26 war or declared missing in action. A VETERAN OF THE ARMED FORCES <--OF THE UNITED STATES, INCLUDING A RESERVE COMPONENT OR THE 27 28 NATIONAL GUARD, WITH A SERVICE-CONNECTED DISABILITY WHO HAS BEEN 29 DISCHARGED OR RELEASED FROM SERVICE UNDER CONDITIONS OTHER THAN DISHONORABLE SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM THE PAYMENT OF REAL PROPERTY_ 30

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1 TAXES IMPOSED BY THE COMMONWEALTH OR ANY OF ITS POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS ON THE PRIMARY RESIDENCE OCCUPIED BY THE VETERAN AS 2 3 FOLLOWS: (1) IF THE VETERAN HAS BEEN RATED BY THE UNITED STATES 4 DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS OR ITS SUCCESSOR AS NOT LESS THAN 5 50% DISABLED UP TO 100% DISABLED, THE VETERAN SHALL BE EXEMPT 6 FROM THE PAYMENT OF A PORTION OF REAL PROPERTY TAXES EQUIVALENT 7 8 TO THE DISABILITY RATING OF THE VETERAN. 9 (2) A VETERAN WHO IS COMPENSATED AT THE 100% DISABILITY RATE THROUGH A FEDERAL PROGRAM THAT PROVIDES COMPENSATION TO VETERANS 10 WHO ARE UNABLE TO WORK DUE TO A SERVICE-CONNECTED DISABILITY AND 11 12 THE UNMARRIED SURVIVING SPOUSE OF A SERVICE MEMBER WHO DIED IN 13 THE LINE OF DUTY, WAS TAKEN AS A PRISONER OF WAR OR WAS DECLARED 14 MISSING IN ACTION SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM THE PAYMENT OF ALL REAL 15 PROPERTY TAXES. 16 (3) THE EXEMPTION UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL APPLY TO THE 17 UNMARRIED SURVIVING SPOUSE OF A VETERAN WHO WAS DEEMED ELIGIBLE 18 FOR THE EXEMPTION PRIOR TO THE DEATH OF THE ELIGIBLE VETERAN. 19 Section 2. The following procedure applies to the proposed 20 constitutional amendment in this joint resolution: 21 (1) Upon the first passage by the General Assembly of the amendment, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall 22 23 proceed immediately to comply with the advertising 24 requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution 25 of Pennsylvania. 26 Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of (2) 27 the amendment, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall 28 proceed immediately to comply with the advertising 29 requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution 30 of Pennsylvania. The Secretary of the Commonwealth shall

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submit the amendment to the qualified electors of this
Commonwealth at the first general or municipal election which
meets the requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the
Constitution of Pennsylvania.
