9 Knowingly engaging in a course of conduct or (5) 10 repeatedly committing acts toward another person, including 11 following the person, without proper authority, under circumstances which place the person in reasonable fear of 12 13 bodily injury or causes substantial emotional distress to the 14 person. The definition of this paragraph applies only to 15 proceedings commenced under this title and is inapplicable to any criminal prosecutions commenced under Title 18 (relating 16 17 to crimes and offenses).
