A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth
- of Pennsylvania, providing for a constitutional right to
- 3 carry.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby resolves as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 7 Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
- 8 That Article I be amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 <u>§ 21.1.</u> Right to carry.
- 10 Every citizen shall have the right to carry openly or
- 11 concealed, carry loaded or unloaded, train with, transport,
- 12 possess, use, acquire, purchase, transfer, inherit, buy, sell,
- 13 give or otherwise dispose of or receive any firearm or self-
- 14 <u>defense device without a license</u>, permission or restriction of
- 15 any kind.
- 16 Section 2. The following procedure applies to the proposed
- 17 constitutional amendment in this joint resolution:
- 18 (1) Upon the first passage by the General Assembly of

the amendment, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall
proceed immediately to comply with the advertising
requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution
of Pennsylvania.

(2) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of the amendment, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania. The Secretary of the Commonwealth shall submit the amendment to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth at the first general or municipal election which meets the requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania.
